



The Speedway Club's Policies and Procedures O'Reilly Auto Parts 500 Weekend • March 28-31, 2019

Checking In

- The Speedway Club doors become a gate on Thursday, March 28.
- Entry will be denied without an appropriate event ticket.
- Members and guests must check in each race day to receive a wristband. Members will need membership card and a valid photo ID. Guests must be accompanied by member for check in.
- Resident, Non-Resident and Corporate Members may have parties of no more than six (6) people per membership.
- Family, Crystal and Corporate Gold Lifetime Members/Designees may have parties of no more than ten (10).

Billing

- Only members with accounts in good standing will be granted access.
- Call Haley at 817-215-8482 to settle all balances by March 22; payments made after will incur a \$25 convenience fee.

Pit Passes

- Resident, Non-Resident and Corporate Members may check out (2) two-hour pit passes per membership, per day. You must be at least 18 years or older to enter the pits. If not returned after two hours, account will be charged for their value.
- Family, Crystal and Corporate Gold Lifetime Members may check out (4) VIP weekend-long pit passes per membership/designee.
- Each person receiving a pass must be present during check-out to present a valid photo ID and sign a liability release form.
- There are no exceptions to the number of pit passes. Additional passes may be purchased from the ticket office (817) 215-8500.

Post-Race Party & Champagne Toast with Ring Presentation by Jostens

- Reservations are required (817-215-8434) and serve as an obligation to purchase the reserved number of tickets.
- Cancellations must be made at least 72 hours prior to the event. For any unclaimed tickets, the full amount will be charged to member account.
- Tickets may be picked up at the 8th floor rotunda desk prior to the event. After the checkered flag, tickets may be purchased on the 9th floor until sold out.
- Please note, the winning driver is not guaranteed to attend; refunds will not be given.

Dress Code Policy

- Dress code is applicable on the 8th and 9th floors.
- Members are responsible for assuring their guests adhere to the dress code.
- Management reserves the right to deem what is appropriate attire.

Suggested:

- Upscale Casual // Collared shirts are required for men
- Jeans, dress shorts, tennis shoes and dress sandals

Prohibited

- Ragged, tattered and/or abbreviated wear
- Screen printed attire
- Flip-flop style footwear
